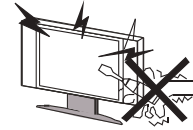


## 1. INTRODUCTION

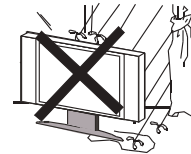
Thank you for buying our TV. Please read this manual carefully.

### 1.1. CAUTION

To avoid the risk of electric shock, do not remove the back cover of the TV.



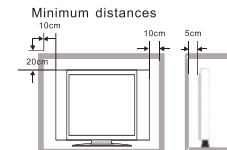
To prevent fire or electrical shock, do not expose the main unit to rain or moisture.

 Do not put too close to curtains/wall or in a bookcase or any similar places that may cause poor ventilation.



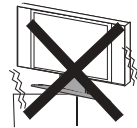
Please note that minimum distances must be maintained for ventilation.



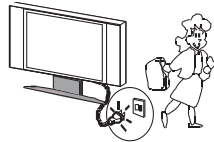
The TV should be placed where children are unable to stand on or push the unit.

## 1.2. COMMEN SHORTCUTS

### Standby function:

When your TV is Running,press“Power”to enter standby mode in any case. When your TV is in Standby Mode,press “Power” to start it.

### Sleep function:

When your TV is Running,start sleep function by pressing the button “sleep” in any case. This function allows you to power off the TV within a period of time. Currently the supported time period are: Off,10 Mins, 20 Mins,30Mins, 60Mins, 90 Mins, 120 Mins, 180 Mins, 240 Mins,

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problems	Check
No picture	Check if the power is plugged in . Check if the Power switch is in “ on “ position
No sound	Check if the volume is set to minimum or mute position
Noise sound	Make the transfer of any contagious generates IR away from the television.
Remote control not working	Check if the batteries are working Check if anything is blocking the sensor .
NO TV signal	Check if the TV/AV is set to TV . Check if the antenna is connected Check if the TV is installed correctly
Picture too light or dark	Adjust Colour ,brightness ,Contrast .
lose colour / snow /ghost images	Check if Antenna is broken/disconnected/damaged .
Poor reception	Adjust “ fine tuning”
Stripes on Picture	Check if there is interference from other broadcasting sources .

preferred source, and the button “enter” or “->” in the end.

### Info function:

Whatever source it is, it will display the information of the current source when pressing down the button “info”, eg: channel number, color system, sound system, (in TV source), current frequency, bandwidth, event information, etc (in DTV source)

### Mute function:

Whatever source it is, it will mute the sound when pressing down the button “mute”, and unmute the sound with another press on it.

### Set up picture mode:

Whatever source is, parameters of the displayed picture, like luminance/contrast/sharpness/hue/color, will be changed when pressing down the button “PMODE”. This function can also be realized in mainmenu.

### Set up sound mode:

Whatever source it is, parameters of the sound, like balance/max volume/min volume, will be changed when pressing down the button “SMODE”. This function can also be realized in mainmenu.

### NICAM:

Switch on/off sound effect or switch between Mono,Dual I/Dual II by pressing button “MTS/DUAL” in TV or DTV source.

### Aspect ratio:

Whatever source it is, Aspect ratio will be changed when pressing down the button “PSIZE”.

### Numeral button:

When in TV or DTV source,it’s a shortcut to change to the preferred channel pressing down numeral button.

### Back to the last channel:

When in TV or DTV source,it can be changed back to the last channel you selected by pressing down the button “ChannelSwap”.

### Volume adjust:

When in normal playback status, volume can be adjusted by pressing the button “Vol+/-”,and at the same time an adjust menu will pop up to show the current volume.

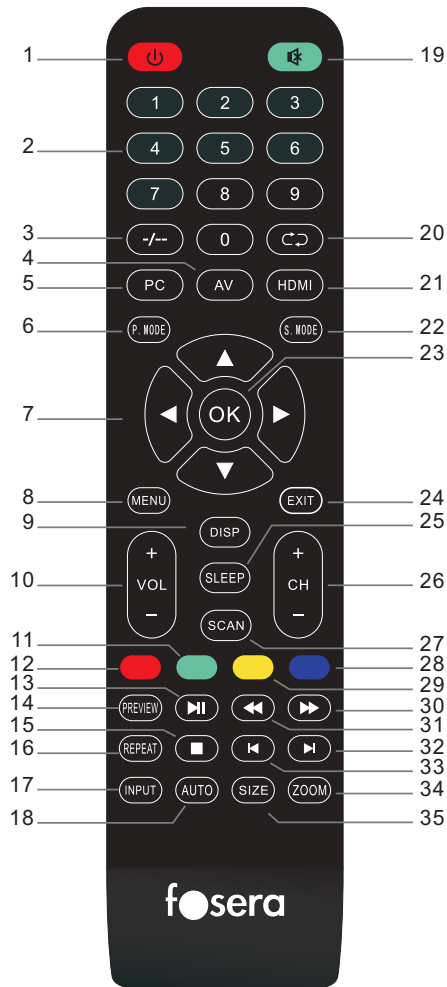
### Channel switching:

- ✦ **PREV PAGE:** Press to the previous page.
- ✦ **NEXT PAGE:** Press to the next page.
- ✦ **PREV.:** Press to play previous text.
- ✦ **NEXT:** Press to play next text.
- ✦ **STOP:** Press to stop and back to folder interface.
- ✦ **Charset:** Press to choose charset.
- ✦ **MUSIC:** Press to play or stop the background music.
- ✦ **PLAYLIST:** Press to view the list of texts.



- ✦ **SET A:** Select AB mode.
- ✦ **PLAYLIST:** Press to view the list of pictures.
- ✦ **INFO:** Press to display the information of the current movie.
- ✦ **SLOW FORWARD:** slow forward
- ✦ **STEP FORWARD:** step forward
- ✦ **GOTO TIME:** select "goto time" to setup play time.
- ✦ **ZOOM IN:** Zoom the movie in.

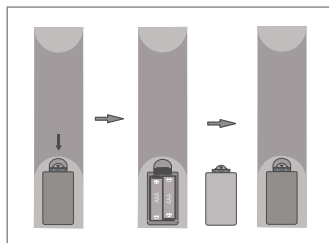
#### 1.4. VIEWING THE CONTROL PANEL



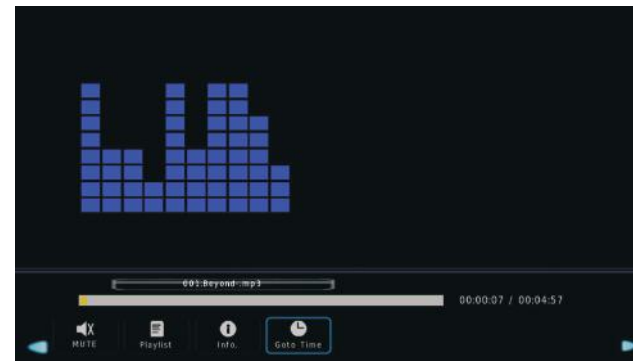
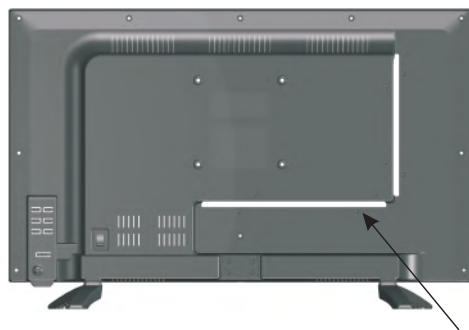
1. **VOL+/VOL- BUTTON**  
Press to decrease or increase the volume. Also used to select items on the on-screen menu.
2. **CH+/CH- BUTTON**  
Press to change channels or to highlight various items on the on-screen menu.
3. **SOURCE BUTTON**  
Displays a menu of all the available input sources (TV, VIDEO, S-VIDEO, PC). You can also use the SOURCE button on the TV's control panel to make selections.
4. **MENU BUTTON**  
Press to see an on-screen menu.
5. **POWER BUTTON**  
Press to turn the TV on/off. Blinks and turns off when the power is on and lights up in standby mode. Light Detecting sensor adjusts brightness of screen automatically by detecting brightness of the surrounding environment. This sensor works when the Brightness sensor is on.
6. **REMOTE SENSOR**  
Receives signals from the remote control. Power indicator: blue light when the TV is on, red light when the TV is in standby.

### 1.5. EXTERNAL SCHEMATIC

1. Insert two AAA batteries with polarities matching the mark inside the battery compartment.
2. Point the remote control towards the IR sensor on the TV. The remote control may not work if it is being blocked by an object.
3. Replace the battery once the remote control is no longer working.
4. If the remote control is not being used, please remove the batteries.



### BACK PANEL



- ✦ **MUTE:** mute on or off.
- ✦ **PLAYLIST:** select "playlist" to display play list.
- ✦ **INFO.:** Select "info" to display the music information.
- ✦ **GOTO TIME:** select "goto time" to setup play time.

### 4.3. MOVIE

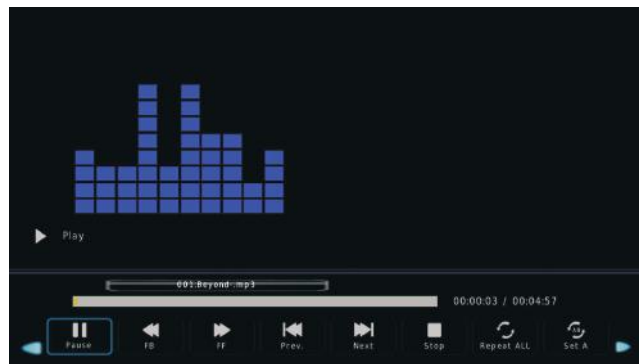


- ✦ Press ENTER to display the menu.
- ✦ **PLAY/Pause:** Press to play or stop.
- ✦ **FB:** Press to play slower.
- ✦ **FF:** Press to play faster.
- ✦ **PREV.:** Press to play previous movie.
- ✦ **NEXT:** Press to play next movie.
- ✦ **STOP:** Press to stop and back to folder interface.
- ✦ **Charset:** press to choose charset.
- ✦ **REPEAT ALL:** Press to select the repeat mode: Repeat 1/ALL/None.



- ✦ **ROTATE:** Rotate counterclockwise.
- ✦ **ZOOM IN:** Zoom the picture in.
- ✦ **ZOOM OUT:** Zoom the picture out.
- ✦ **MOVE VIEW:** Zoom out the picture first, Highlight the icon and press ENTER, then press ▼/▲ & ◀/▶ to move the picture.

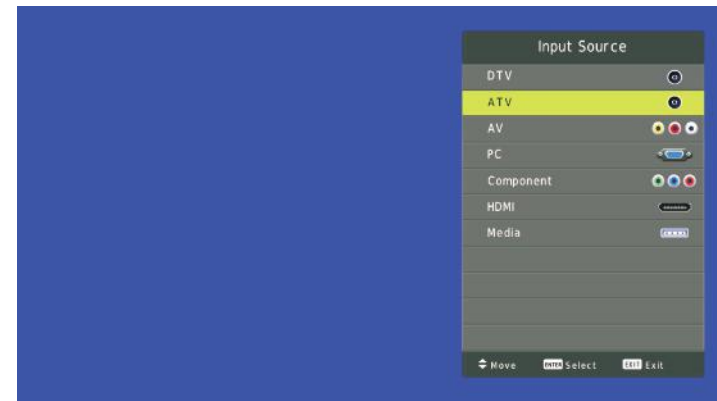
- ✦ Press ENTER to display the menu.

- ✦ **STOP:** Press to stop and return to folder interface.

## 2. SETUP

### 2.1. Key Functions Description

- a) **POWER:** Power on or off.
- b) **MENU:** Enter the main menu, or return to previous menu or exit the main menu.
- c) **CH +/-:** Channel up or down, OSD up or down.
- d) **VOL +/-:** Volume increase or decrease, OSD left or right.
- e) **SOURCE:** To change source, or to enter next menu.

### 2.2. INPUT SOURCE

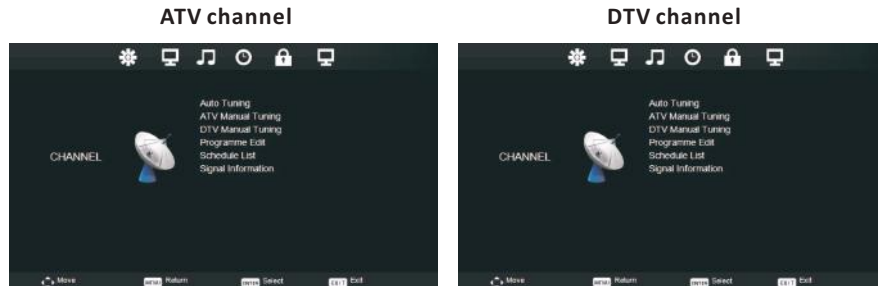


- ✦ Press SOURCE to show input source list.
- ✦ Press ▲/▼ to select and ENTER to confirm.
- ✦ The menu will be automatically hidden in a few seconds, or press EXIT to clear on-screen menu.

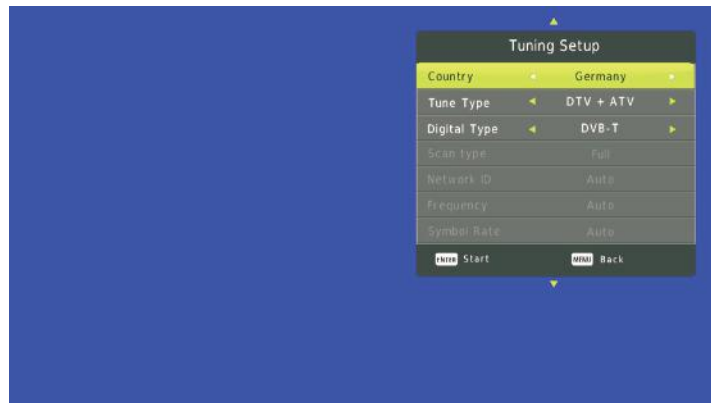
### 3. Menu Function Description

#### 3.1. CHANNEL MENU

✦ The channel menu is available only in DTV and TV mode.



#### 3.1.1. AUTO TUNING



- ✦ Auto Tuning can find out all effective channel automatically.
- ✦ **Country:** press ◀ or ▶ to choose country
- ✦ **Tune TYPE:** press ◀ or ▶ to choose tune type
- ✦ press ENTER to start auto searching.
- ✦ If you want to stop searching, press MENU, and press ◀ to confirm or ▶ to cancel.

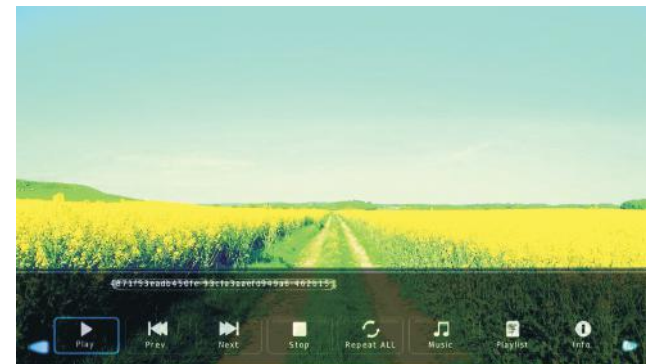
### 4. MEDIA

The color of the icon means whether your TV has detected a USB memory or not. Blue: Yes; Gray: No;



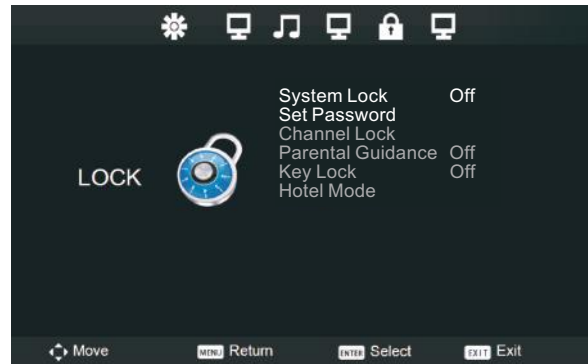
Press ◀/▶ to select Photo/Music/Movie/Text icon and ENTER to enter the USB memory. For details,

#### 4.1. PHOTO



- ✦ Select a picture file and press ENTER to view, and it will display all the pictures in the folder automatically. Press ENTER to display the following menu.
- ✦ **PLAY/Pause:** Press to play or stop the slideshow.
- ✦ **NEXT/PREV.:** Press "NEXT/PREV." button to skip to view the photo which are selected the photo.
- ✦ **STOP:** Press "STOP" button to stop and return.
- ✦ **REPEATALL:** Press ENTER to select the repeat mode: Repeat 1/ALL/None.
- ✦ **MUSIC:** Press to play or stop the background music.
- ✦ **PLAYLIST:** Press to view the list of pictures.
- ✦ **INFO.:** Press to display the information of the current picture (Resolution/Size/Date/Time)

### 3.5. LOCK MENU



- ✦ Press MENU to display the main menu , and press ◀/▶ to select the Lock Memu.
- ✦ **System Lock** : System lock switch.
- ✦ **Set Password** : Set the system password lock.
- ✦ **Channel lock** : Lock the channel.
- ✦ **Parental Guidance**:
- ✦ **Key lock**: lock the key

### 3.6. OPTION MENU



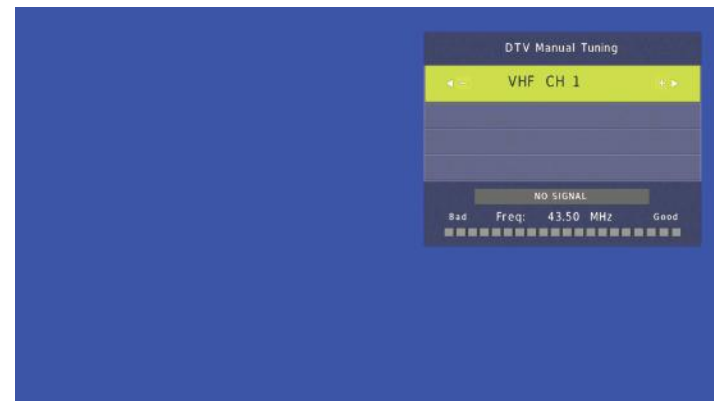
- ✦ Press MENU to display the main menu , and press ◀/▶ to select the Option Memu.
- ✦ **OSD Language**: Set the OSD display language. (Chinese/English).
- ✦ **TT language**: Set the image-text and nicam language.
- ✦ **Audio Languages/Subtitle Language**: Press to select the items.
- ✦ **Hearing Impaired**: Press to set the Hearing Impaired to “on” or “off”.
- ✦ **PVR File System**: Set the recording file system.
- ✦ **Aspect Ratio**: 16:9
- ✦ **Blue screen**: select blue screen or not.
- ✦ **First Time Installation**: Press “▶” or “ok” to enter relevant options including OSD Language and Country.
- ✦ **Reset**: Recall the default setting.
- ✦ **Software Update(USB)**: To upgrade the software.
- ✦ **HDMI CEC**: Press to select HDMI CEC/Auto Standby/Auto TV/Device control/Device List

### 3.1.2. ATV MANUAL TUNING



- ✦ Manul Tuning can search up or down, and will pause when find a channel.
- ✦ **Current CH 1**: press ◀ or ▶ to choose channel number
- ✦ **Sound System DK**: press ◀ or ▶ to choose sound system type
- ✦ **Fine-Tune**: press ◀ or ▶ to fine-tune the current frequency
- ✦ **Search**: Press ◀ to search down from the current frequency, and press ▶ to search up.

### 3.1.3. DTV Manual Tuning



- ✦ **VHF CH 1**: press ◀ or ▶ to choose channel number
- ✦ press ENTER to start auto searching.

### 3.1.4. PROGRAMME EDIT



- There are four shortcut keys for programming the channel.
- First press ▼/▲ to highlight the channel , then:
- ✦ **Delete:** Delete the channel.
  - ✦ **Move:** Set the channel to moving state then press ▼/▲ to move it to the position you want.
  - ✦ **Skip:** Skip the selected channel. (Your TV set will skip the channel automatically when using CH+/-.)
  - ✦ **Enter \Select :** Press to confirm.
  - ✦ **Menu\Back :** Press to return to previous menu.

### 3.2. PICTURE MENU



- ✦ Press MENU to display the main menu, and press ◀ / ▶ to select the Picture Menu.
- Highlight the item and press ▼/▲ to select corresponding sub-menu.
- ✦ **Picture Mode :** Mild/Dynamic/Standard/User.
- ✦ **Contrast :** / ✦ **Brightness:** / ✦ **Colour:** / ✦ **Tint :** / ✦ **Sharpness:**
- ✦ **Color Temperature:** Select the color temperature that you feel comfortable.
- ✦ **Noise Reduction:** You can clear up input signal by set the item.
- ✦ **MPEG Noise Reduction:** Press to select off/low/middle/high/default.

### 3.3. SOUND MENU



- ✦ Press MENU to display the main menu, and press ◀ / ▶ to select the Sound Menu.
- ✦ **Sound Mode:** Standard/Music/Movie/User /sports
- ✦ **Treble :**Treble adjust
- ✦ **Bass :**Bass adjust
- ✦ **Balance:** Adjust the level of sound coming from the left and right speakers.
- ✦ **Auto Volume:** When set on, quick volume change will be smoothed.
- ✦ **SPDIF MODE:** Press to select off/pcm/auto
- ✦ **AD Switch:** Press to select audio.

### 3.4. TIME MENU



- ✦ Press MENU to display the main menu, and press ◀ / ▶ to select the Time Menu.
- ✦ **Clock:** Sets the system time.
- ✦ **Time Zone:** select time zone
- ✦ **Sleep Timer:** Select the time in minutes(10min,20min,30min,60min,90min) that you want the TV to shut off automatically after you set the time. Cancel by setting it to Off.
- ✦ **Auto standby:** Press to select off/3H/4H/5H
- ✦ **OsD Timer:** Set display time of OSD(5s,10s,15s,20s,25s,30s).
